January 18, 1942 - February 19, 2024

Our loving mother and grandmother, Joretta (Jetty) Diane Clapp, 82 of Defiance, Ohio passed away peacefully at Lakeland Rehab and Healthcare Center, Angola, Indiana on February 19, 2024 after a long illness, surrounded by her loving family.
