Myrna Joyce (Milnor) Blair, 79, of rural Napoleon, Ohio died Monday, January 22nd, 2018 at Defiance Area Inpatient Hospice Center. She was born February 12, 1938 in Bowling Green, Ohio to the late Harold and Marjorie (Heiby) Milnor. On April 28, 1968, she married Robert C. Blair at Bowling Green United Methodist Church.

Joyce was a 1956 graduate of Bowling Green High school and 1961 graduate of Bowling Green State University. She was a homemaker and florist, which came second hand, as she grew up in a floral and greenhouse business. She owned and operated Blair's Flower Shop and also worked at Harold's Flower Shop. She worked at Campbell Soup Company, Napoleon for 19 years until retirement and formerly worked as a school teacher in Monroe.

She was a member of Sharon United Methodist Church, Napoleon and former member of St. Paul Lutheran Church, Napoleon. She was also a member of McClure American Legion Ladies Auxiliary, Eastern Star, and Gleaner. She was a former Henry County 4-H Advisor.

She is survived by her husband, Bob; children, Amy Blair, James Blair, and John Blair; grandchildren, Clayton Blair, Gabriel Gomez, and Kathryn "Katie" Shultz; and a brother, Jerry (Billie) Milnor of Bowling Green. She was also preceded in death by 2 infant sisters, Martha Grace and Lois Arlene.
