June Louise Kreisler Morgan, age 94, passed away on Thursday, October 4, 2018. She was born in Van Wert, Ohio on June 14, 1924 to Walter and Amelia (Becker) Kreisler.

June graduated from Van Wert High School in 1942. She married Richard Lininger in March 1944 and he was killed in France during WWII in August 1944. June married William Morgan on October 1, 1949; he preceded her in death in July 1996.

She was a member of First Presbyterian Church of Napoleon, where she was active in the Women's Association, taught Sunday School, and served on the Board of Deacons. June also volunteered for many years with the American Cancer Society, and at the Henry County Hospital Gift Shop. June enjoyed being a member of the American Legion Woman's Auxiliary.
