John J. Kania April 20, 1924-July 16, 2009 John Joseph Kania, 85, of West Palm Beach, Florida and formerly of Custar, Ohio died Thursday afternoon, July 16, 2009 in West Palm Beach, Florida. He was born April 20, 1924 in Toledo, Ohio to the late Walter and Stella (Ratajczak) Kania. In February of 1945 he married Rosemary Sturtz and she preceded him in death in 1969. On December 11, 1970 he married Wilma (Cox) Saunders at St. Louis Catholic Church, Custar and she survives. John served in the Marine Corps during World War II in the Mariana Islands on Saipan and Tinian and the Marshal Islands on Roi-Namur. He was wounded twice and received two purple hearts. He was a member of the Norcross-Meyers American Legion Post #305, Custar for over 62 years. John always enjoyed golfing and was a past member of the Bowling Green Country Club. John is survived by a daughter, Rosanne (Thomas) Tussing; four sons, David (Patricia) Kania; Dennis (Lois) Kania; Steven (Deborah) Kania and Thomas (Sheri) Kania; three stepsons, Paul (Sandra) Saunders; Ronald (Carmen) Saunders; Dan R.
