Karen S. Ellinwood, 84, of Lima, Ohio passed away on December 1, 2024. She was born October 4, 1940 to Henry and Olga (Hagen) Sayles in Billings, Montana. On June 14, 1959, Karen married Darlynd Ellinwood.

Karen attended Radford Private High School in El Paso, Texas, and graduated from Meeteetse Wyoming High School. She attended the University of Wyoming and Bowling Green State University.
