July 5, 1941 - October 19, 2018

Karen Kay (Henrich) Good, 77, formerly of Napoleon, passed away peacefully on October 19, 2018 with her loving family by her side at her home on Lake Erie, in Huron, Ohio, a short seven months after a diagnosis of inoperable pancreatic cancer.
