Kathryn Ann Rubinstein, 74, of Napoleon, Ohio died peacefully on December 10, 2022 at Fulton Manor, Wauseon, Ohio with her family by her side. She was born January 21, 1948, a single child to the late Keith and Margaret (Love) Niehaus.

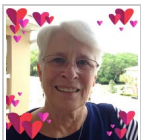
