Kay Ann Johnson, 56, of Napoleon, Ohio died Thursday, October 30, 2014. She passed away at the University of Michigan Hospital in Ann Arbor, Michigan after a short, courageous battle with cancer. She was born December 22, 1957 in Wauseon, Ohio to Vern Schott and Mary (Weber) Bockelman. On October 16, 1982 she married John Johnson at St. Luke Church in Wauseon, Ohio. He survives in Napoleon.

Kay worked as coder of health information for Henry County Hospital for 15 years and Fulton County Health Center for 25 years. She was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church, Napoleon. She belonged to the Daughters of the American Legion and AHIMA. Kay enjoyed gardening, flowers, dogs, traveling, watching her sons and husband play golf, and watching football.
