Keith E. Wyse, 58, of Ridgeville Corners, Ohio died on Friday, January 6, 2017 at his residence. He was born on October 13, 1958 in Napoleon, Ohio to the late Marlin and Marie (Dehnke) Wyse. On November 19, 1977 he married Cheryl Dietrich at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Napoleon, Ohio.

Keith graduated from Four County Joint Vocational School in the diesel mechanics program in 1977. He worked at Benecke Trucking for 15 years and then the Ridgeville Elevator for 15 years. In 2001 he started missions work and moved to China full-time in 2002. In 2012, he and his family moved back to Ridgeville Corners, but he still continued his missionary work.

Keith attended Life Changing Realities in Edgerton, Ohio and was a member of St. Peter Lutheran Church in Ridgeville Corners, Ohio and also a member of River of Grace in Beijing, China. Keith loved the outdoors and enjoyed fishing, driving semi truck, and helping others.
