Ruth M. Kieffer, 78, of McClure, Ohio died Friday morning, February 29, 2008 at her son's residence in Gahanna, Ohio. She was born March 14, 1929 in McClure, Ohio to the late Cecil M. and Mary E. (Kistner) Bretz. On February 22, 1952 she married Glenn "Sandy" Kieffer in Celina, Ohio and he preceded her in death on February 5, 1996. Ruth graduated from Deshler High School in 1947 and from Bowling Green State University in 1950 with a B.S. in Education. She was a 2nd Grade school teacher at C.D. Brillhart in Napoleon, Ohio for 23 years, retiring in 1986. She had previously taught in Celina, Ohio for two years. She was a member of the Custar Church of Christ, Henry County Genealogy Society, Henry County Historical Society, Henry County Retired Teachers Association; the Ohio Retired Teachers Association; and the Delta Zeta Chapter of Delta Kappa Gamma Sorority. She is survived by 4 sons, David (Donna) Kieffer, Gahanna, Ohio; Brad (Trish) Kieffer, West Lafayette, Ohio, Jack (Denise) Kieffer, Hilliard, Ohio, and Brian (Jean) Kieffer, Greenwich, Ohio; Daughter-in-law, Mary Kieffer (Ralph) of Custar, Ohio; 16 grandchildren; and 2 great grandchildren. She was also preceded in death by 2 sons, Rodney Kieffer and Ralph Kieffer, and a brother, Martin Bretz. Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. on Tuesday at the Rodenberger Funeral Home, Napoleon, Ohio with Pastor James Erven officiating. Interment will follow in the Milton Township Cemetery, Custar, Ohio. Visitation will be held from 2-8 p.m. on Monday at the funeral home.
