Regis N. "Slim" Kieffer, 84, of Malinta, OH died Sunday, March 1, 2009 at his residence. Born September 7, 1924 in Duquesne, PA to the late Alvin & Bertha (Kremmel) Kieffer. On July 23, 1948, he married Wilma Fredericks in Jeffersonville, IN, who survives in Malinta. Slim worked for Tri-County Electric and Toledo Edison for 36 years. Owned and operated the Home Restaurant of Malinta and managed Malinta Mutual Telephone Company. He was a member of Malinta Memorial UMC Church. He was former Mayor of Malinta and helped start Malinta's first rescue squad, as he served on the Malinta Fire Dept. for over 20 yrs. He was a member of the Henry County Sheriffs Dept. Auxiliary and Malinta Police Department for 15 years. Member of the NRA and Maumee Valley Sportsman Club, as he loved to fish and play golf. He also traveled to all 50 states and 7 countries with his beloved wife. He served the U.S. Army during the W.W.II, where he received the Bronze Star for his part in the Battle of the Bulge. He was a life member of the Malinta Legion Post 400 and Napoleon VFW 8218.
