Laurence Burdette "Unky" Kinder, 91, of Deshler, Ohio died Tuesday morning, March 18, 2008 at his residence. He was born on September 21, 1916 in Hamler, Ohio to Ora M. and Elizabeth (Reinbolt) Kinder, Sr. On October 19, 1940 he married Juliette J. Schippers at St. Paul Catholic Church, Hamler and she survives. Laurence served with the U.S. Army during World War II from 1942-1945. He worked for CSX Railroad for over 40 years, retiring in 1976. He had also worked at the former Koppenhofer Brothers Poultry in Deshler for 18 years. He was a member of Immaculate Conception Catholic Church, Deshler. Along with his wife, they were coordinators of the Deshler Council of Churches Food Pantry for over 33 years. He was also a member of the Warren L. McIntyre American Legion Post #262, Hamler; FISH of Henry County and a volunteer with Meals on Wheels. Laurence is survived by his wife, Julie; a sister, Pearl Kinder, Billings, Montana; his beloved pet, Bernie II; and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by a sister, Irsel Tietje and three brothers, Dale "Sparky" Kinder; Ora "Curley" Kinder and Robert Kinder. A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. on Tuesday at Immaculate Conception Catholic Church, Deshler with Fr. Jeff Nordhaus officiating. Interment will be in Woodlawn Cemetery, Deshler where military honors will be accorded by the Warren L. McIntyre American Legion Post #262. A luncheon will follow in the church fellowship hall. Visitation will be held from 2-8 p.m. on Monday at the Rodenberger Funeral Home, Deshler where a Rosary Service will be held at 7:30 p.m. in the funeral home. The
