Lawrence E. (Larry) Schuette, 89, of Napoleon, passed away on Saturday, October 17, 2015, at St. Vincent Heart and Vascular Center, Toledo. He was born October 26, 1925 in Napoleon Twp. to the late Herman and Frieda (Panning) Schuette. He graduated from Florida High School in 1943. On April 29, 1951 he married his loving wife Marilyn (Dietsch) Schuette and enjoyed 64 years of marriage.

Larry was Vice President of Midwest Plant Food in Napoleon for 15 years and owned and operated Augustine & Hoeffel in Napoleon for 15 years. He was the second hired employee of the first Napoleon Walmart where he ended his working career after many years of retail sales.

He was a dedicated lifelong member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Napoleon Twp., where he served as Council President and Sunday school teacher. He was President of the Northwest Ohio Luther League Association, Napoleon Twp. trustee, member of the U.S. Army - 103rd infantry, where he was awarded the Bronze Star for "Heroism in Action", member of Napoleon American Legion, and member of the Honest Farmer Coffee Club, at the Henry County Senior Center.
