Lee Conn Miller, 90, passed away at his home, surrounded by his family on Thursday, November 5, 2020. He was born in McClure, Ohio to the late Otto F and Mary O (Conn) Miller. He married Arlene Showman on September 5, 1954 at Emmanuel Lutheran Church, Napoleon.

He graduated from McClure High School in 1948. Lee was a member of the social club 5H. He served two years in United States Army during the time of the Korean war. Lee took over the family farm raising registered Holsteins after his father was killed in a farming accident. He farmed until the early 1990's and during that time was a member of the Farm Bureau. After farming Lee went on to work at Walmart for 13 years.

Lee enjoyed fishing, golfing, dart ball and gardening. He was known for raising giant oxbart tomatoes, which won multiple awards at the Henry County Fair. Lee was an avid golfer and during one of his outings, he shot a hole in one which made the local newspaper.
