



Lemuel (Lem) O. Teague

Lemuel Oscar Teague, 88, of Osseo, MI died Monday, March 10, 2014 at Bronson Battle Creek Hospital in Battle Creek, MI. He was born May 15, 1925 to the late Lemuel Oscar, Sr. and Annie May Laura (Lee) Teague . On January 7, 1957 he married Betty Jeanne (Allen) Teague in Liberty Center, OH.
