Leon J. Coressel, 76, of Napoleon, Ohio died peacefully on Friday, May 18, 2018 at CHP Defiance Hospice with his family by his side. He was born on December 5, 1941 in Atlanta, Georgia to the late Nelson and Clara (Davis) Coressel. On June 17, 1972 he married Carol (Wiechers) Coressel.

Leon served in the US Airforce from 1961- 1969 and was deployed to fight in the Vietnam War. He worked as a Meat Cutter for over 55 years and retired from Chief Supermarket in Napoleon. He attended the Napoleon Crossroads Church and was a member of the Napoleon American Legion, VFW, and AMVETS Posts.

Leon was an outdoorsman. He was an avid hunter and fisherman, an accomplished woodworker, and enjoyed landscaping in his yard. He also loved chopping wood and tending to his birdfeeders. Most of all, he cherished his family and always looked forward to family reunions.
