



Leon Clement St.Clair

June 8, 1939 - July 1, 2024

Leon Clement St.Clair, 85, long time resident of Henry County, Ohio passed away peacefully on Monday, July 1st, 2024 at his residence after fighting a 2 year battle with cancer.

Leon was born in Gorham, NH on June 8, 1939 to the late Albert and Marcelle (Legendre) St.Clair.

At the age of 17, Leon enlisted in the United States Marine Corp. and served from 1957-1963.

While stationed in North Carolina, he met Rosetta Prigge in April of 1958.

They married on May 20th, 1958.

Together they raised 5 children, Julie (Bob) Heath, Mark (Janet) St.Clair, Mary (Kerry) Fegan, Jean St.Clair, and Eric (Courtney) St.Clair. Leon and Rose have 12 grandchildren and 21 great grandchildren. He is also survived by his siblings, Emile (Carol) St.Clair, Jane (Kenny) Geider, and Joan (Tom) Gough. He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother, Paul St.Clair.

Leon's strong work ethic provided for a solid foundation for his wife and entire family.

Not only did he serve in the Marines, he drove truck cross country, worked for Roy Weasel in shipping and installation. He also started his own business, St.Clair's Electric Motor and Machinery Company. Leon semi-retired in his early 50's.

He was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church, Napoleon, Ohio.
