Leonard G. Miller, 85, of Ridgeville Corners, Ohio died peacefully on Saturday, August 12, 2017 at his residence. He was born in Adam's Township, Ohio on November 18, 1931 to the late Alvin and Helene (Wiemken) Miller. He was baptized and confirmed his faith in his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.
