Leonard James Schweter, 90, of Napoleon, Ohio, passed away on Thursday, March 5, 2025. He was born on December 4, 1935, to the late Herman and Eleanor (Gross) Schweter in Berea, Ohio. On August 25, 2003, he married Sandee Wright in Las Vegas, Nevada.

Lenny was a parishioner of The First Presbyterian Church of Napoleon. He served his country proudly in the U.S. Army Single Core and was assigned TDY to Thule Air Force Base in Greenland. Lenny worked for J.R. Holcomb Educational Materials for 29 years and worked up to the position of Senior Vice President of Operations. He was an avid golfer, who achieved two hole-in-one's. 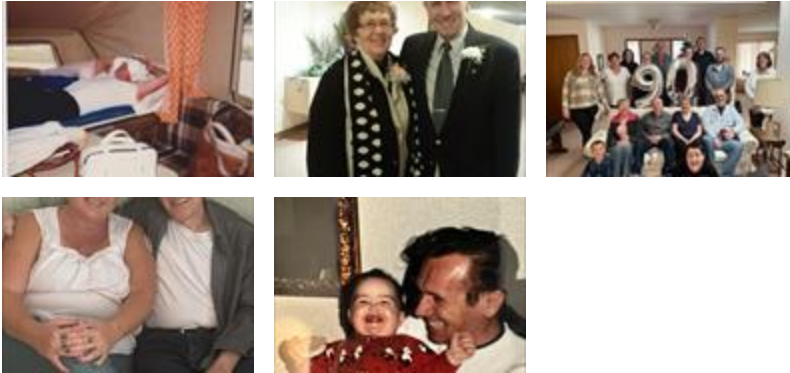
