Lloyd W. Harms, 86, of Napoleon, died Friday, December 11, 2015 at St. Luke's Hospital, Maumee, Ohio. He was born December 25, 1928 in Monroe Twp., Ohio to the late Lawrence & Hazel (Brinkman) Harms. On April 5, 1953, he married Jeanette Frysinger at Liberty Chapel Church.

Lloyd was a lifelong farmer and also delivered mail on a rural route for many years. He was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church, Flatrock Twp., where he held several positions in the church. He served in the U.S. Army as a sergeant from 1951-1953. He served as Historian and member of the Color Guard funeral detail for the Bert G. Taylor American Legion Post #300, Napoleon. As a young man, he helped his uncle install Drive-In movie theaters throughout the area.

Lloyd's passion was music. When he wasn't listening to it, he was playing it. He loved singing and entertaining with his harmonica and guitar at many nursing homes and various local events. He also loved to travel with his wife Jeanette and visited all 50 states.

He is survived by his wife, Jeanette, daughters; Karen Harms of Napoleon and Becky (Tim) Prigge of Hamler. Grandchildren; Kirk, Nathan, and Chad Williams, Kristin (Adam) Campos, and Kari Prigge, great grandchildren; Carmen and Damien Campos. He was preceded in death by an infant son, David Lloyd, and sister, Elaine Baker.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 15 at St. Paul Lutheran Church, Flatrock Twp. Interment will follow at the church cemetery,

where military honors will be accorded by the Napoleon Joint Veteran Posts.

Visitation will be held on Monday from 2-8 p.m. at Rodenberger Funeral Home, Napoleon and Tuesday from 10-11 a.m. at the church.
