



Lloyd Kane

September 12, 1922 - January 8, 2018

Lloyd E. Kane, 95, of McClure, Ohio died Monday, January 8th, 2018 at Genacross Lutheran Services – Napoleon Campus. He was born September 12, 1922 in Liberty Center to the late James E. & Blanche (Miller) Kane. On July 7, 1943, he married Deloris (Zimmerman) Kane in Whitehouse, Ohio and she preceded him in death on November 6, 2006.

Lloyd was a graduate of McClure High School. He was drafted and joined the U.S. Army Air Corp. and attained the rank of Staff Sargent while he served in Europe. He was a radio operator on a B-17 Bomber and was shot down on his 23rd mission and became a prisoner of war.

After the war, he worked as a Television and Radio repairman. He worked at Napoleon Radio Service for 7 years and Frank's Sales in Bowling Green for 29 years.

He was a member of McClure United Methodist Church, McClure American Legion, and the D.A.V. He enjoyed gardening and was an amateur radio operator (W8QCL).

He is survived by his children, Sharon (LJ) Schuster, Robert (Roberta) Kane, and Patricia (Gary) Sherman, all of McClure, 7 grandchildren, and 14 great grandchildren. He was also preceded in death by a granddaughter, Julie Kane, brothers, Norris and James Kane, and sisters, Mary Wumer, Irene Phillips, Helen Anderson, and Norma Baker.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. on Friday, January 12 at McClure United Methodist Church. Interment will follow at Hockman cemetery where

military honors will be accorded by McClure American Legion.

Visitation will be held on Thursday from 4 – 8 p.m. at Rodenberger Funeral Home, McClure and Friday from 10 – 11 a.m. at the church.
