Lois J. Plotts, 78, of McClure, Ohio, was called to her heavenly home on Wednesday, August 2, 2017, surrounded by her loving family, after a challenging four years with cancer. She was born on April 4, 1939 to the late William and Marjorie (Biddle) Gasche in Pettisville, Ohio. On September 8, 1956, she married Forrest L. Plotts.

Lois was a homemaker and a LPN at Wood County Hospital where she was once honored as employee of the month and then continued her compassion as a nurse at Dr. Steven Dood's office in Waterville until her retirement in 2012. Lois was caring and kind, always serving others with a smile. She was a member of Country Chapel Christian Union Church in rural McClure where she attended faithfully, always offering her time and service. She was a long-time member of the Christian Union Women's Fellowship (CUWF), organizing and participating in many activities. Volunteering for McClure EMS and the Red Cross was important to her and she was proud to have donated over nine gallons of blood. Lois was active in Henry County 4-H for many years, being an advisor and an advocate for her children's many activities. She especially loved traveling with Forrest, having visited all 50 states and many countries outside the USA. Of all the things she loved, her family was the most loved, enjoying her grandchildren and great-grandchildren every chance she could. Most cherished were the family gatherings that started with a 50th wedding anniversary week with the family in Kiawah Island, South Carolina. They decided then to make it an annual event, celebrating their 60th anniversary

with the family last year.
