Loren "Bud" Sheeks, 76, of Bowling Green, died Saturday night, July 18, 2015.

He was born September 17, 1938 in Wood County, Ohio to the late Melvin and Charlotte (Nickols) Sheeks. On June 1, 1956 he married Ellen Ducat and she preceded him in death. On April 13, 2002 he married Leona (Wachter) Boyer.

Bud was a welder for over 19 years at Daybrook, Bowling Green. In the mid 70's he started the family business, Sheeks Farm Drainage.

He was a member of Dayspring Assembly of God, Bowling Green. Bud was an avid coon hunter, loved blue grass country music, old western movies, camping and making his own folk art instruments. He will be remembered as an ornery, fun-loving man, cherished by his family.
