



## Lucille Meyer

February 7, 1919 - May 29, 2018

Lucille L. Meyer, 99, of Napoleon passed away Tuesday, May 29, 2018 at Genacross Lutheran Services, Napoleon Campus. She was born in Fulton County on February 7, 1919 to the late John and Amelia (Glanz) VonSeggern. She married Rudolph Meyer on May 7, 1939. He preceded her in 1981. Lucille was the oldest living member of St. Paul Lutheran Church, Napoleon. She was a member of the Mission Society and was a long time Sunday School Teacher. In her earlier years she loved playing the piano. Lucille worked for the Sears store in Napoleon for about 30 years and spent her time helping her husband on the family farm. She and Rudolph were former members of the Henry County Farm Bureau. She was an avid Cleveland Indians fan. She loved her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. Lucille spent 24 winters in Yuma, Az.

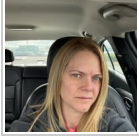
