



## Mae Loraine Dietrich

May 21, 1927 - September 15, 2020

Mae Loraine Dietrich, 93, of Napoleon, Ohio passed away on Tuesday, September 15, 2020 at St. Luke's Hospital in Maumee, Ohio. She was born in Toledo, Ohio on May 21, 1927 to the late Charles and Frances (Decker) Dille. On July 24, 1948, she married James Dietrich at St. Paul Lutheran Church, Napoleon and he preceded her in death on February 13, 2019.

Mae was a 1945 graduate of Napoleon High School and attained her Registered Nursing Degree from Maumee Valley School of Nursing, Toledo, Ohio. She worked for Dr. Winzler and Dr. Manahan, as well as the Heller Memorial Hospital and Henry County Home, Health, and Hospice.

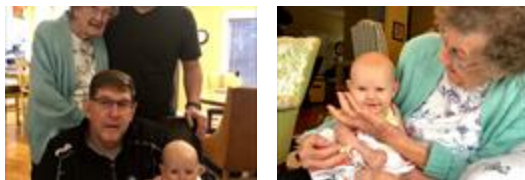
