Marilyn Louise Huston, 95, of Napoleon, Ohio passed away on Saturday, July 25, 2020. She was born on October 20, 1924 in Napoleon to Henry and Laura (Glanz) Rettig. 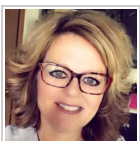
