Marjorie Mae Wachtmann, 85, a lifelong resident of Napoleon, Ohio died peacefully on Friday, March 25 at her residence surrounded by family and friends. She was born July 13, 1930 in Defiance County to the late Gale "Jim" & Mabel (Zenz) Shumaker. On December 3, 1949, she married Raymond H. Wachtmann, who preceded her in death on December 3, 1998.
