Marvin G. Yagel, 69, of Napoleon, Ohio died Tuesday, June 17, 2014 at Amherst Health Center, Amherst, Ohio. He was born May 24, 1945 in Hillsdale, Michigan to the late Hubert W. and LaVerne (Bowman) Yagel. On October 07, 1967, he married Donna Jean "D.J." Soals, who survives in Napoleon, Ohio.

Marv was the former owner and operator of the Napoleon Harley Davidson shop. He served in the US Army during the Vietnam War as an air traffic control operator. He was also a member of the Bert G. 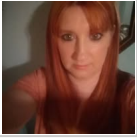
