Mary E. (Helberg) Rosebrock, 82, of Archbold, Ohio went to be with her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on Tuesday, February 14, 2017 at Fairlawn Haven, Archbold, Ohio.

Mary was born on September 30, 1934 in Flatrock Twp., Ohio to the late Carl & Bernice (Rettig) Helberg. She was baptized as an infant and was confirmed as a young adult and attended Zion Lutheran Church of Ridgeville Corners throughout her married life.
