Marvin L. Meyer October 14, 1931-May 15, 2013 Marvin Lawrence Meyer, 81, of Deshler, Ohio died Wednesday morning, May 15, 2013 at the Defiance Inpatient Hospice Center. He was born October 14, 1931 in Bartlow Township, Ohio to the late Carl and Luella (Bartels) Meyer. On June 20, 1954 he married Margareth Wachtman and she preceded him in death on March 21, 1972. On August 19, 1973 he married E. Elaine (Moser) Meyer at Peace Lutheran Church, Deshler. Marvin was a 1950 graduate of Deshler High School and served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. Marvin worked at Clevite Harris, Napoleon from 1953-1968; at the Deshler Elevator from 1968-1982. 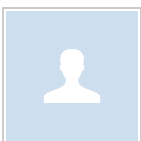
