



Rev. Norman F. Norden

July 14, 1937 - February 10, 2014

Reverend Norman Ferdinand Norden, age 76 of Malinta, Ohio, entered the Church Triumphant on the afternoon of February 10, 2014.

He was born July 14, 1937 at the home of his parents Ferdinand and Mathilda (Badenhop) Norden in Henry County, Ohio. He graduated from Ridgeville High School in 1955 and then received a Bachelor of Arts from Capital University, Columbus, Ohio in 1960. He received a Bachelor of Divinity from the Evangelical Lutheran Theological Seminary in Columbus, Ohio in 1963. He interned at Trinity Lutheran Church in Mobridge, S.D. In June 1963 he was ordained into the ministry at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Napoleon Township, Ohio.

He married Wanda Wiemken in 1960. Norm and Wanda, along with their children, served in Papua New Guinea as Lutheran missionaries spreading the Christian gospel for 16 years, the last 6 years of which he was the Stewardship Director of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Papua New Guinea. Upon return to the United States, Norm served as the pastor of Hope Lutheran Church, Hamler, Ohio for 19 years until retirement in 1999. Norm was a missionary and pastor to the church, well-loved and highly respected. He was one of those saints who labored faithfully and made a difference in the lives of many others. He was active in the community, serving on numerous boards and committees. He was the kind of disciple Jesus was talking about when he urged us to be the "salt of the earth".

Norm is survived by his loving wife, of 53 years, Wanda and 3 children, Chris (Danielle) Norden of Enon, Ohio, Lisa (Kevin) Ehlert of West Chester, Ohio and Rachel (David) Downs of Dublin, Ohio, 5 grandchildren Ethan and Brenton Norden, Enon, Ohio, Daniel and Philip Downs, Dublin, Ohio and Kylie Ehlert, West Chester, Ohio. Sisters; Florence Behnfeltdt, Defiance, Ohio, Mary Ann Iliff, Defiance, Ohio Margarite (Melvin) Lanzer, Napoleon, Ohio, and Gladys Dachenhaus, Paulding, Ohio, sister-in-law; Joan (Leonard) Norden, Napoleon, Ohio and brother; Dan (Toni) Norden Ravenna, Ohio, numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents; Ferdinand and Mathilda Norden and brother; Leonard Norden.

Visitation will be from 6pm to 8pm on Thursday and 2pm to 4pm and 5pm to 8pm on Friday at Rodenberger Funeral Home Napoleon.
