Paul Barry Howe, 82, of Napoleon, Ohio died Wednesday, August 19, 2015 at St. Vincent Medical Center in Toledo, Ohio. He was born April 4, 1933 in Napoleon to the late James and Mary (Spangler) Howe. On July 27, 1957, he married Joanne Y. McClure at St. Patrick Catholic Church, Grand Rapids, Ohio. She preceded him death on March 1, 2012.
