Peggy H. Christman, 91, of Perrysburg, Ohio and formerly of Deshler, Ohio went home to be with her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, on Tuesday, December 20, 2016 at Kingston Residence of Perrysburg.

She was born June 24, 1925 in Kannapolis, North Carolina to the late William Edward and Maude Ruth (Self) Huff. On September 18, 1945 she married Edward Christman in Charlotte, North Carolina and they shared over 66 years together before he preceded her in death on November 1, 2011.
