Richard "Pete" Travis, 84, of Coldwater, Michigan and formerly of Napoleon, Ohio passed away on Wednesday, November 11, 2020. He was born in Napoleon on November 20, 1935 to Raymond and Norma (Stevens) Travis. Pete married Nancy Druhot on February 20, 1988 at St. Paul Lutheran Church, Napoleon.
