



## Robert Hershberger

February 7, 1935 - May 22, 2023

Robert “Bob” Neil Hershberger, 88, passed away on Monday, May 22, 2023 at Genacross Lutheran Services, Napoleon after a brief illness.

Robert was born in Monroe Township, Henry County, Ohio, to Maud “Hazel” Hershberger on February 7, 1935. He was baptized on April 5, 1936 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Malinta and confirmed on June 5, 1949 at Emanuel Lutheran Church in Napoleon. Bob Graduated from Napoleon High School in 1953.

On November 4, 1956, Robert married Marilyn E. Rosebrock, who survives along with their two children, Scott (Laura) Hershberger of Ottawa, Ohio and Pam Hershberger of Maumee, Ohio; three grandchildren, Danielle (Steve) Dickman, Adam (Kerry) Hershberger, and Grant (Carly) Hershberger; and four great grandchildren, Emma and Kate Dickman, Brody and Baylor Hershberger, and one on the way in September. Also surviving is his brother Jerry (Marilyn) Hershberger of Napoleon. Robert was preceded in death by his mother and siblings, Erma (Hersh) Ludeman, Howard (Irma) Overhulse, and Jim (Arlene) Hershberger.

Robert worked for his brother at Howard’s Friendly Service Station for 16 years and then for CF Gerken and Gerken Paving for 36 years, where he was lovingly referred to as Uncle Bob. After retiring, he mowed for the City of Napoleon Parks and Rec Department. Robert was an active member of St. Paul Lutheran Church, Napoleon for 54 years, serving as a trustee and an usher.

Robert served in the Army Reserves for six years. He was a hard worker and was well known for his cleanly washed cars, his well-trimmed trees, and his large garden. He loved to play cards and watch his beloved Detroit Tigers. In his later years, he was well known for pushing his grocery cart down the street to get the daily mail. He was a beloved husband, father, grandfather, and brother who will be so missed by all who loved him.
