Rollie Ruskey, Jr., 85, of McClure, Ohio died Thursday, April 25th, 2024. He was born May 7, 1938 to the late Rollie and Jessie (Nulton) Ruskey. The family lived on a farm outside of Deshler, Ohio. 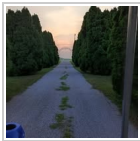
