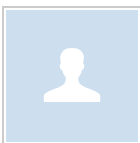

The last time we saw each other we made a point to take pictures together, to recreate old photos, I wish we could recreate another.. you were and always will be so special to me!

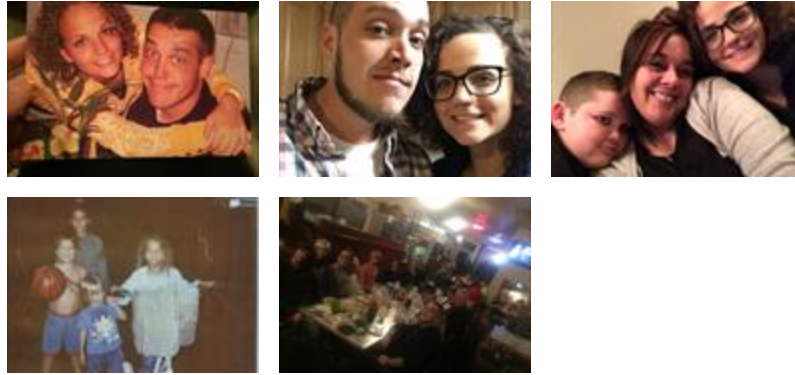
I hurt for you, for your mom, my sweetest Aunt Mischa. I wish this wasn't real.
