Ronald "Doc" Dachenhaus, 74, of Napoleon, died Saturday, October 25, at the Defiance Inpatient Hospice Care Center. He was born September 2, 1940 in Napoleon Twp., to the late Herman and Dorothea (Lineau) Dachenhaus. On May 5, 1962, he married Janis Rosebrook at Peace Lucheran Church in Deshler.
