Ronald R. Schueler, 86, of Napoleon, Ohio died Wednesday, May 6, 2015 at CHP Inpatient Hospice Defiance. He was born June 27, 1928 in Napoleon, Ohio to the late Ray and Leona (Strohl) Schueler. On August 30, 1980 he married Marilyn Cordes at St. Paul Lutheran, Napoleon Township.
