Frederick "Fritz" Rosebrock, 86, of Napoleon, Ohio died Wednesday, August 26, 2008 at his residence. He was born December 5, 1921 in Ridgeville Corners to the late Henry & Anna (Hasemeier) Rosebrock. He was preceded in death by 4 sisters, Frieda Omeke, Clara Reynolds, Esther Rosebrock, Helen Rosebrock, and 1 infant great granddaughter, Mya Nicole Rosebrock. Funeral services will be held at 11a.m. on Saturday, August 30, 2008 at the Zion Lutheran Church in Ridgeville Corners, Ohio. Interment will follow at the church cemetery with military honors accorded by the Ridgeville American Legion.
