Ruth L. Barnes, 98, of McClure, Ohio died peacefully on Easter Sunday, April 12th, 2020 at her Napoleon Alpine Village residence.

She was born May 2, 1921 in McClure, Ohio to the late Clyde and Chloe (Hadley) Houser. On March 1941, she married Karl "Bob" Barnes in Deshler, Ohio and he preceded her in death on September 14, 2006.

Ruth graduated from McClure High School. She was a homemaker and helped her husband on the farm. Henry County Tomato Pageant, life member of the McClure American Legion Auxiliary, and 4-H advisor for the Richfield Stars That Shine for 25 years.

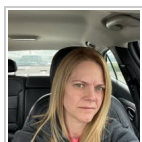
