Robert W. Sautter, 83, of Grelton, peacefully passed away Sunday, December 5, 2010, at Golden Living Center-Northcrest in Napoleon Ohio. Bob was born August 20, 1927 in Custar, Ohio to the late Chalmer and Helen (Baumbarger) Sautter. On June 25, 1950, the day the Korean War began, he married Jacqueline Howe of Grelton. He later left and saw active duty in the Korean War, where he watched over the prisoner exchange at Panmunjom. Bob attended Malinta United Methodist Church. He was a member of 4 Corners Historical Society, a life-time member of Patrick Henry Athletic Boosters, Napoleon VFW and the American Legion. He was an active member of Malinta Post 400 of the American Legion, and served many years as Trustee of Grelton Cemetery. Bob had farmed prior to the Korean War and when he returned home he became a Deputy Sheriff in Henry County. He also worked at Harris Product, co-owned Howe and Sautter Implement Sales, Bailiff for the Napoleon Municipal Court for many years, and most recently, a retiree from the State of Ohio Department of Highways in Bowling Green, as a bridge inspector. He also worked several years for Rodenberger Funeral Home. He is survived by his wife, Jacqueline; daughter, Renee (Dan) Yoder of Archbold; three grandchildren, Cara (Todd) Sterken of Toledo, Trent Yoder of Archbold, and Stephen Desgrange of Wauseon; three great-grandchildren, Sophie and Caroline Sterken, and Cailynn Desgrange, and a brother-in-law, Gary Howe of Grelton. He was also preceded in death by two daughters, Roxanne and Shellie. As Robert's last request, his body was donated as an anatomical gift

to the University of Toledo. A Celebration of Life Service for Bob will be held at 11 a.m. on Saturday, December 18, 2010 at McClure United Methodist Church with Pastor Mary L. Kay officiating.
