Roger J. Schulze, 59, of McClure, OH died Tuesday at St. Luke's Hospital in Maumee, OH. He was born October 9, 1949 in Napoleon to the late Harvey and Luetta (Cordes) Schulze. 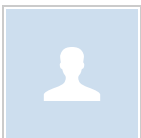
