



## Shirley E. Winseman

March 24, 1917 - March 28, 2014

Shirley E. Winseman, 97, of Napoleon, died Friday, March 28, 2014 at Henry County Hospital.

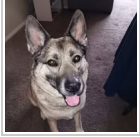
