Harley W. Spangler February 28, 1929-September 23, 2011 Harley Wayne Spangler, 82, of Deshler, Ohio died Friday, September 23, 2011 at his residence. 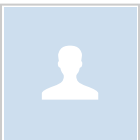

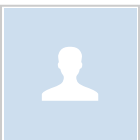
