



Steven Frederick Buchhop

December 14, 1956 - November 4, 2020

Steven Frederick Buchhop, 63, of Archbold, passed away from lung and bone cancer on Wednesday, November 4, 2020 at CHP Defiance Area Inpatient Hospice Center surrounded by his family. He was born in Napoleon on December 14, 1956, to Marvin and Marlene (Wiemken) Buchhop. On June 6, 2015, he married Dawn Short and she survives.

A 1975 graduate of Liberty Center High School and Four County Vocational School, Steven was employed by Sauder Woodworking in Archbold for 28 years and previously worked for Koncor Industries in Wauseon. He was a member of St. John Lutheran Church, Stryker.
