Tracy L. (Lowry) Martin, 53, of Napoleon, Ohio died unexpectedly Monday, December 21, 2015 at Henry County Hospital. She was born November 19, 1962 in Napoleon to the late Harry Lowry and Sharon (Gruber) Kessler.

Tracy graduated in 1984 as a Registered Nurse from St. Vincent School of Nursing. She worked as a registered nurse and nursing supervisor at Henry County Hospital for the last 30 years.
