Mary Catherine Wagner, 91, of Custar, Ohio died Monday afternoon, April 7, 2008 at Birchaven Retirement Village, Findlay, Ohio. She was born January 7, 1917 in Custar to William and Catherine Mary (Maas) Durliat. On May 4, 1940 she married James A. Wagner at St. Louis Catholic Church, Custar and he preceded her in death on September 16, 1992. Mary Catherine graduated in 1935 from Milton Township High School and along with her husband; they operated the Custar Tavern from 1960-1980. She was a lifetime member of St. Louis Catholic Church, Custar and the church's Altar & Rosary Society and St. Cecilia Organization. She was also a 62 year member of the Norcross-Meyers American Legion Post #305 Auxiliary, Custar and a former Girl Scout Troup leader. She is survived by a daughter, Joyce (Jerry) Walker, Custar; two sons, James (Brenda) Wagner and John (Barb) Wagner, both of Custar; 9 grandchildren and 13 great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by three brothers, Clarence, Richard and Bernard Durliat. A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. on Friday at St. Louis Catholic Church, Custar with Fr. Paul A. Fahrbach officiating. Interment will be in St. Louis Catholic Cemetery and a luncheon will follow in the St. Louis School basement.
