October 29, 1922 - February 28, 2017

Waldo Elmer Imbrock, 94, of Napoleon, Ohio, died on Tuesday, February 28, 2017 at Henry County Hospital in Napoleon, Ohio. He was born on October 29, 1922 in Henry County, Ohio to the late Martin and Laura (Koppenhofer) Imbrock.

Waldo worked for Magnavox in Ft. Wayne and then served in the US Navy from 1943-1946 during WWII. On June 13, 1946, he married Clara H. Bostelman at Bethlehem Lutheran Church Adams Ridge Road. They moved to Defiance County and Waldo became a dairy farmer and Honegger feed salesman, for over 55 years. In that time, he developed a herd of high quality registered Holsteins. After he retired, he moved to Napoleon and became a greeter at the Napoleon Walmart and had the distinction of being known as "Waldo from Walmart"

Waldo was a member of Bethlehem Lutheran Church Adams Ridge and held several positions in the church over the years. He served on several dairy boards, 4-H advisor for "Our Gang" and was inducted into the 2014 Defiance County Agriculture Hall of Fame.

He is survived by his children, Sharon Miller of Defiance, Ohio, Kathleen (Dean) Francisco of Southport, North Carolina, Rodney Imbrock (Tina McQuillin) of Wauseon, Ohio, and Vickie (Mike) Moser of Defiance, Ohio; grandchildren, Lisa (Mike) Baxter, Ryan (Jen) Imbrock, Christopher and Jason Malone, Kristian (Renee) Imbrock, Holly (Sam) Tedrick, Danielle and Jeffry McQuillin, Amiee Moser and Alex Moser; great grandchildren, Amanda (Josh)

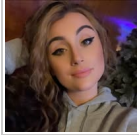

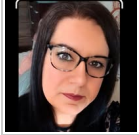
