Walter Frank Woltmann, 79, of Deshler, Ohio passed away Tuesday, February 4, 2014 at the VA Hospital, Ann Arbor, Michigan.

He was born November 21, 1934 in Lutherville, Arkansas to the late George and Alice (Doepel) Woltmann. The family later moved to Wauseon, Ohio. On November 2, 1958 he married Shirley "June" Godeke.

Walt enlisted into the U.S. Army Reserves in 1957 and served active duty during the Cuban Missile Crisis from 1961-1963. He was a retired farmer and previously worked as a mechanic and truck driver.

He was a member of St. John Lutheran Church, Deshler and Warren L. McIntire American Legion Post #262, Hamler, Ohio.
